ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS

Day 1 – Friday, March 15

TRAVEL DAY

Meal Inclusions: None

- Morning Arrive at Horton early in the morning. Load the coach and depart for the United States. Lunch and dinner en route.
- Evening Arrive at your hotel near Boston late in the evening.

Day 2 – Saturday, March 16

WORKSHOP AND BLUE MAN

Meal Inclusions: Breakfast, Dinner

- Morning Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then board the coach and travel to New England Conservatory for a **concert band workshop**.
The New England Conservatory of Music in Boston is the oldest independent school of music in the United States, and it is widely recognized as one of the country's most distinguished music schools.

- Afternoon Travel to **Quincy Market** for lunch.
Quincy Market was built in the 1800s to serve the downtown Boston area. It is currently a popular and busy lunchtime spot for downtown workers, featuring a large variety of food. There is a two-story seating area surrounding the central dome.



- After lunch, walk to the **New England Aquarium**.
The New England Aquarium, which opened in 1969, is a global leader in ocean exploration and marine conservation. The Aquarium is one of the premier visitor attractions in Boston, with over 1.3 million visitors a year, and a major public education resource.



- Evening Walk back toward the Faneuil Hall Marketplace and visit the **Hard Rock Café** for dinner.

- Board the coach and travel to the Charles Playhouse to take in **Blue Man Group**.
Blue Man Group will rock your world. Blow your mind. And unleash your spirit. It won't call your mom on her birthday. Or will it? (Do you want it to?) Leave your expectations at the door and let three bald and blue men take you on a spectacular journey bursting with music, laughter and surprises.



- Return to your hotel for the night.

Day 3 – Sunday, March 17

NYC TOUR AND SINGING DINER

Meal Inclusions: Breakfast, Dinner

Morning Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then check out. Board the coach and travel to New York.

Afternoon Lunch en route.

Take **tour of New York City** (coach and walking).

Evening Enjoy dinner and entertainment at **Ellen's Stardust Diner**.

Ellen's Stardust Diner is the home of the singing wait staff in Times Square New York City. A Multi-level '50s-themed diner with singing servers & an extensive menu of American classics.



After dinner, take a walk through Times Square to see the lights at night. Afterward, board the coach and travel to your hotel in New Jersey.

Day 4 – Monday, March 18

PERFORMANCE AND CRUISE

Meal Inclusions: Breakfast, Dinner

Morning Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then travel a local school and put on a **performance** for the students.

Perform for students at a local school. Details to be determined.

Afternoon Travel toward the upper east side to visit the **Metropolitan Museum of Art**. Eat lunch while on-site.

The Metropolitan Museum of Art is the largest art museum in the United States and one of the most visited museums in the world. It houses a wide range of art, including paintings and sculptures, weapons and armour, musical instruments, and an Egyptian temple.



Evening Travel to the Hudson River and board a ship for a **Sparkling NYC Skyline Dinner Cruise**.

Day 5 – Tuesday, March 19

BROADWAY

Meal Inclusions: Breakfast

Morning Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Travel to the **One World trade center**, then take the elevator up to the **observatory**.

Positioned on top of the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere, on levels 100, 101, and 102 of the 1,776 foot tall One World Trade Center building, One World Observatory provides unique, panoramic views of New York City, its most iconic sites, and surrounding waters.



Afternoon Take the coach to Times Square for lunch before taking a guided tour of **Radio City Music Hall**.

Radio City Music Hall is an entertainment venue located in Rockefeller Center in New York City. Its nickname is the Showplace of the Nation, and it was for a time the leading tourist destination in the city. Its interior was declared a city landmark in 1978. More than 300 million people have come to the Music Hall to enjoy stage shows, movies, concerts, and special events.



After the tour, take some more time to explore and shop around **Times Square**.

Times Square is one of the world's busiest pedestrian areas and the hub of the Broadway Theatre District. It's known for the New Year's Eve ball drop and has been featured in numerous movies and TV shows.



Evening Eat dinner on your own in the area, then walk to the theatre to see **Dear Evan Hansen** on Broadway.

Both deeply personal and profoundly contemporary, Dear Evan Hansen is a new musical with award-winning music and lyrics by Benj Pasek & Justin Paul (La La Land and The Greatest Showman) about life and the way we live it.



Return to your hotel for the night.

Day 6 – Wednesday, March 20

MUSEUM AND TRAVEL

Meal Inclusions: Breakfast

Morning Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then check out and board the coach. Depart for Boston.

Afternoon Stop for lunch en route. After arriving in Boston, visit the **Museum of Science**.

The Museum of Science has over 700 interactive exhibits featuring such topics as rocks and minerals, plants, mounted animals, models of manned space capsules, computers, the universe, the human body, and electricity. The museum features a number of live presentations throughout the building every day.



Evening Continue toward home, stopping for dinner en route. Check in to a hotel near South Portland for the night.

Option: Order pizza to the hotel for the group before bed. (subject to extra cost)
