Horton High School Music Trip 2019 Chaperone Application

Adult chaperones will be needed for the Horton Music Trip taking place March 15th to 21st, 2019. Chaperoning can be a fulfilling experience but it is also a considerable responsibility. For chaperones, this will be a working trip as well as a fun one. The ability to function with potentially little sleep or in frustrating situations with teenagers is essential. These general guidelines apply to all chaperones:

- The School Administration will assemble a group of chaperones who can work together successfully and form a cohesive group that includes all skills necessary for the trip
- Each chaperone will be responsible for 8 or 9 students
- Chaperoning means being responsible for other people's children who may have different backgrounds and behavioral norms than yours
- Chaperones will assist with trip preparation work beginning in October.

 This may include helping to develop the itinerary, develop and assist students with band trip fundraisers, meeting with parents and students to discuss plans and concerns, and participating in all trip related meetings and functions.
- Chaperones will assist and help assure the safety of students while on the trip. This may include performing head counts, being aware of special needs, dispensing medications, knowing where students are at all times, meeting regularly with school and tour staff and other chaperones to exchange information and solve problems that may arise.
- Consistent with current AVRCE policy, chaperones will have to undergo background checks, - the child abuse registry and criminal/police records checks, and vulnerable sector screening
- All chaperone application forms will be forwarded to the School Administration for approval and final decision.
